## Town of Springvale Columbia County, WI Minutes, Regular Board Meeting March 11, 2025 Springvale Town Hall

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM with the reciting of the flag pledge.

Minutes of the February 10 meeting were read; motion by Glen, seconded by John and carried to approve the minutes.

Treasurer's Report Checking: \$119,451.53 Savings: \$137,029.47 CD: \$150,000 Motion by John, seconded by Glen and carried to approve the treasurer's report.

Review of bills: Motion by John, seconded by Glen and carried to approve payment of the bills.

Town Hall Building Committee: Paul Bernander briefly outlined the next steps that the Board will have to take, hopefully in the next month or so.

- Chairman Fischer thanked the committee, and stated he understood the charge to the Town Hall Building Committee was to get to a vote, and therefore he felt the current committee ends tonight. His expectation is that the Board will appoint a new committee to plan the building.
- The Board decided to have a second meeting in March to discuss more thoroughly the next steps. Arnie Fischer and Ellen Richter will be invited to that meeting since they are candidates for the Board. The date will be March 25 at 6:30 PM.

Pardeeville District Ambulance Commission: Andy reported on the progress the Village of Pardeeville has made on their proposed buy-out of the Ambulance Commission. They want to have this completed by April 1, but the municipalities want a list of payments that need to be settled. More information and a request to vote on this will be coming.

Road Maintenance: Discussion on Taylor Road, which puddles very badly when it rains. Glen felt we have a contract with Michels about road damage; this will be looked for. Missing road signs were found on a resident's property. Recycling Center: Melissa Flores asked if the recyclables are actually recycled, or if the fire last year stopped that practice at the County. Ryan Hart stated that the recyclables are properly recycled and gave locations where that takes place. The Board and residents were reminded that the annual large item pick-up day will be April 5.

There was no other business.

The next regular monthly meeting was set for the second Tuesday, April 8 at 6:30 PM. The Annual Town meeting will be held on the date set by last year's Annual meeting, Wednesday, April 16, at 7 PM.
